Want to be a leader at one of our school holiday camps?

These are a great time to grow and serve God and we have so many leaders coming back each year as they have enjoyed it so much!

What does it take to be a Kids Camp leader?

You need to be a committed Christian, 15 years or older. We do make some exceptions for leaders who are 14 years with very good references.

If you are a first time leader you will need to complete a Leaders Application Form (see back page). We will then let you know by mail or email if you have been accepted as a leader.

There will be a Leaders Weekend before each Kids Camp. You must be able to attend the Leaders Weekend for the camp you are applying for.

What's involved with being a Kids Camp Leader?

Kids Camps are held each school holidays and cater for 8-12 year olds. Each camp has a theme and generally runs for 5 days.

As a Kids Camp Leader you will be responsible, with a co-leader for the supervision and care of a cabin of 6 campers. It will be a full-on time but highly rewarding. You will learn about leadership, grow in your own faith, make new friends and witness first hand, God at work, changing kid's lives.

What does it take to be an Emerging Leader?

Emerging leaders need to be 13 years and older. They will need to fill out a Leaders Application Form (see back page). We will then let you know by mail or email if you have been accepted.

There will be a Leaders Weekend before each Kids Camp. You must be able to attend the Leaders Weekend for the camp you are applying for.

What's involved with being an Emerging Leader?

As an Emerging Leader you will be serving in a variety of ways...dishes, assisting with games and craft time, helping with canteen etc. These tasks may not be glamorous but they are essential and your help will be greatly appreciated.

You will be given leadership training, learn new skills, make new friends and be encouraged in your own walk with the Lord.
